To be eligible for the NFBA Scholarship, the applicant must be: Age 18 or under; Be a student of Elementary, Middle, High School or Home Schooled. Reside at the home of Parents or Guardians that are current NFBA members; Have a desire to play Bluegrass Music, Plays a Bluegrass Instrument, Scholarship will be made payable to an accredited music teacher. Must write an Essay and submit, along with application, to the NFBA Scholarship Committee no later than August 31, 2010 (Must be postmarked by 08-31-2010.)
